

2026 Self-Sufficiency Table
250% of Federal Poverty Income Guidelines

An individual in the North Central Workforce Development Area is considered to be at self-sufficiency if the entire household's income is at or above 250% of the Federal Poverty Income Guidelines (FPIG).

8	\$55,720	\$139,300

For families/households with more than 8 persons, add \$5680 to Poverty Guideline and \$14,200 to 250% Poverty Guideline for each additional person.

NOTE: This table is adjusted yearly based on FPIG.
